

## PURCHASE INFORMATION

At the Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary, we will do everything we can to assist you in selecting the right horse for your family. American Wild Mustangs and Registered Paints and Quarter Horse weanlings, yearlings and two and three year olds are gentle, leading and ready to load in a trailer. These young horses are available for viewing and purchasing year-round.

### SELECTING AND PURCHASING YOUR MUSTANG OR REGISTERED HORSES

- The best way to view the horses available for purchase is to go to the website [www.wildmustangs.com](http://www.wildmustangs.com) foal sales or check the registered foals on [www.paintsandpalominos.com](http://www.paintsandpalominos.com). Our online catalog is the most current list and is updated on a regular basis. Make sure to check back often.
- Buyers are invited to visit the Sanctuary any time of the year to view and select the horses available for purchase. The new foals start being born in May and continue until early August. There is always a wonderful selection of wild horses and registered horses available **all** year.
- After you select your American Wild Mustang or Registered Paint or Quarter Horse, a non-refundable deposit of 25% of the purchase price is required to hold your horse selection. A conditional bill of sale will be written and a date will be selected for your foal(s) or young horse to be picked up or delivered to you. Our available wild mustang and registered horses are ready to go to their new homes right now. Just make your selection and we will have your newest family member ready for transporting in just a few days.

The full purchase price must be paid before your horse is allowed to leave the ranch.

### WHEN IT IS TIME FOR YOUR FOAL OR YOUNG HORSE TO GO TO THEIR NEW HOMES

Yearlings and older horses are ready to go to their new homes anytime during the year. Weanlings born in the spring are ready to go in the fall. Depending on the available time after gathering and weaning, all of the foals are gentled. The young horses are also taught to lead and load in a trailer before they leave the Sanctuary. Registered foals are ready to leave by late August or early September. Mustang foals are ready to be transported to their new families by late September or early October.

## TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

### TRANSPORTING YOUR FOAL

- Buyers must provide transportation for their foals or young horses. A list of people who can possibly transport your foal(s) for you is available. Just ask.
- Transportation should be in a closed or stock trailer with full doors.
- New owners should bring halters and lead ropes for their foal(s).



### PREPARING YOUR FOAL'S NEW HOME

- The new home for your foals should include a sturdy corral at least 40 to 60 feet wide made of pipe or boards. It should be at least five feet high and have safe gates.
- Some form of shelter is necessary, it can be as simple as a run-in shed.
- A foal usually does better if it has a buddy, so we give special consideration for those who purchase two or more horses.

**FROM A DISTANCE, THE OPEN PRAIRIE IS BREATHTAKING.** Up close it is treacherous. Yucca blades can slice tender flesh, legs can twist in prairie dog holes and rattlesnakes coil behind sandstone outcroppings. A horse born in this environment has to be smart and alert just to survive. The foals raised at the Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary have highly developed senses; unusual intelligence and superb athletic ability that help them avoid hazards on the ground.

When the wild mustangs first came to the Sanctuary over twenty years ago to live the rest of their lives in freedom, the bands were made up of only mares. For several years, there were no foals. In an effort to give the mares a more natural existence, one stallion was introduced.

The presence of a few foals each year allow the wild horse bands to live a more normal life. The raising of these foals helps to calm the mares and give the whole herd a sense of family. Proceeds from foal sales help to support the Sanctuary, providing everything from hay and veterinary supplies to purchasing more open land. Through Horses Helping Horses, you have the opportunity to buy superb horses while helping America's Wild Mustangs.

#### AMERICAN WILD MUSTANG FOALS

Each year foals are available from Painted Desert, our wild Medicine Hat stallion and his band of wild mares. Mustang foals are the spectacular result of natural selection. These foals are born out on the open range and run free with their mothers. Wild Mustang foals gentle quickly to make great saddle animals.

#### AMERICAN SPANISH/SULPHUR MUSTANG FOALS

Don Juan, our red dun wild Sulphur Mustang stallion has a superb band of dun and grulla Sulphur and Spanish Mustang mares. A few select foals are available each year from this band. These foals are spirited and lively and remind us of the type of horses the Conquistadors rode as they came into the west 300 years ago.

Years of survival have created pure and strong bloodlines. Our mustang foals have exceptional endurance, intelligence and sensory awareness.

#### REGISTERED AMERICAN PAINT AND QUARTER HORSE FOALS

Foals are also available from the Cheyenne Canyon Paint and Quarter Horse band of mares and stallions that make their home on the Sanctuary. These registered horses are the culmination of decades of careful breeding. Being born on the open range, provide the foals a natural existence with the experience of walking up and down rocky hillsides. Horses raised in this environment know how to pick up their feet and take care of themselves in the wide open spaces.

The registered Paints and Quarter horses are show quality and make exceptional pleasure or ranch horses. Our stallions and mares are selected for their agreeable dispositions and excellent bloodlines.
